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Introduction

For an educational institution feedback of the parents, students, teachers as well as alumni act as the backbone for its upliftment. Parents' views improve communication that can benefit the institution in many ways. Parents who provide regular feedback are also more likely to understand and support any unique approaches to education or problem solving. They also are more likely to have a higher opinion of the staff and faculty. The benefits of student feedback are deep and wide — but not always recognized. Students have a comprehensive view of how their teachers educate and motivate, giving the educational institution the opportunities to make real-time adjustments i.e., providing better facilities in the campus which help in developing the standard of the institute. Teachers' feedback occupies a prominent position in the strategic development policies. It also helps to improve the accountability of the system. Similarly, alumni feedback helps in evaluating academic progress and development of strategic policies.

Keeping in view the importance of feedback, Dakshin Kamrup College conducts a feedback survey of parents, teachers, students and alumni in every academic session to upgrade the quality of the college in all aspects and provide a better atmosphere for teaching learning process.


Being the most important stakeholders of the institution, parents' feedback especially on curricular aspects are collected which opened up the following information:


- Most of the parents found the discipline of the college campus to be very good and good for their children. A few of them found it excellent too.


The feedback taken from students about the curriculum and the overall infrastructure of the college reveals the following results:


- Most of the students considered the departmental infrastructure of the college to be very good.

TEACHERS' FEEDBACK- 2020-2021

Teachers' being the most important person in curriculum design, implementation and development, feedback of faculty on curricular aspects are of utmost importance. Analysis of the faculty feedback brought about the following information.

- Most of the faculties have considered the course suitable for the syllabus to be very good.
- Majority of them considered the syllabus to be a very good, need based syllabus for the overall development of the students.
- Regarding aims and objectives of the syllabus, maximum of them found it to be very good.
- Majority of the teachers responded that the course content is followed by corresponding reference materials.
- The teachers found a good number of sufficient books in the library.
- Maximum of the faculty members found a good balance between theory and application of the syllabus.
- A very good number of teachers responded that the syllabus made them interested in the subject area.
- Majority of the teachers responded that the syllabus increased their knowledge and perspective in their subject area.
- Most of the faculty found a good number of sufficient optional papers in the course, while some found it to be excellent and very good too.
- A good number of faculty members found the prescribed reference materials as relevant updated and appropriate.
- Regarding the overall infrastructure of the departments, the teachers found it to be very good.


- Regarding the conduction of test and examination in time, the faculty members found the entire system to be very good.

- Maximum of the teachers considered the provisions for professional developments as non –discriminatory and fair.




ALUMNI FEEDBACK 2020-2021


The purpose of the alumni feedback is to understand the alumni's perception on different matters like the academic, extra-curricular and infrastructural status of the college. The feedback collected through Google forms highlighted the following information:

- Most of the alumni rated the quality of teaching as excellent.
- The extra-curricular activities were also rated as excellent by maximum alumni.
- The campus atmosphere, as per the majority of alumni's opinion was very good.
- The sports facilities offered by the college were deemed excellent by the majority of the alumni.
- The alumni's opinions were found to be divided regarding the laboratory facilities. While most of them rated it as good, some others found it to be excellent and very good.
- Most of the alumni found the canteen provisions very good.
- Regarding the hostel facilities, maximum of the alumni found it good during their stay.
- A lot of alumni rated the admission procedure as excellent. A significant number of alumni also found it to good and very good.

- The library facilities were found to be excellent by most of the alumni.


- Student amenities such as Wi-Fi were found excellent by maximum number of the alumni during their time.

- The overall public perception of the institution was similarly rated excellent by the maximum number of alumni.


